Weather Advisory #1 - 3/20/18

March 20, 2018

A winter storm warning is in effect for Hazlet Township, Monmouth County with significant snow accumulations predicted for Wednesday March 21, 2018.

Municipal Administrative offices, Municipal Court, Department of Recreation events, Library and other departmental activities for Wednesday, March 21, 2018 are cancelled and facilities closed.

Hazlet – Township Officials are closely monitoring this developing weather event and are prepared to respond effectively. Essential Township Personnel remain on standby until further notice and deployment. The Township fleet and heavy equipment are serviced; ready for snow removal operations including other emergency response.

Periodic informative advisories may be posted on the Townships website at www.hazletwp.org as this event unfolds and conditions warrant updates or new pertinent information is received. These postings may also appear simultaneously on our Facebook and Twitter feeds.

Police Department - Alerts & Messages

As conditions warrant, Hazlet Township Police Department may also send out mobile **Alerts and Messages 24/7** through their NIXLE Alert System. To receive mobile or email alerts you must first register by clicking on the Nixle Alert icon at the Townships website: www.hazletwp.org and simply sign up for the type(s) of messages you prefer to receive.

OEM - Alerts & Messages

During emergencies and major incidents the Office of Emergency Management may also send out Alerts & Notifications through their **CodeRed** System. This system allows us to telephone all or targeted areas of the Township. To receive these telephone alerts you must be registered in the system; sign up at: www.hazletoem.com

SNOW COVERED ROADWAYS

We ask and thank you in advance for your cooperation and assistance during this event – maintaining roadways free of vehicles and other obstructions!

NO PARKING

We respectfully remind all residents and business owners of the Township's ordinance: ***“whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets or highways, an emergency shall be deemed to exist and no vehicle shall be parked on any of the streets or highways, or portions thereof, within the Township of Hazlet.”***

Note: *“The parking prohibition shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased and until the streets or highways have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with snow plowing or the normal flow of traffic.”*

Your cooperation will help us clear snow covered roadways more effectively and safer without parked vehicles on the road. Remove any other obstructions from the roadway such as portable basketball hoops as well.

OFF-STREET PARKING AVAILABLE

Additional off-street parking is available at the **Hazlet Swim & Tennis Club** parking lot for those with multiple vehicles needing off-street parking spaces.

SNOW REMOVAL

We respectfully remind you: ***“No person, nor the owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Township, it being the intent and purpose of this provision to prohibit all persons from throwing, casting, placing or depositing snow and ice, which accumulated within the private property belonging to the person, upon the sidewalks or streets of the Township.”***

POWER OUTAGES
