- Introductions
- Emmanuel from NJPN presented on Tobacco Free Signs

  - Kait and Nikki sent an email to Emmanuel and Eric from NJPN to request 30 signs for their parks.
- NJCDTF presented on the mapping initiative
  - They presented different options for the town to utilize for mapping
    - Opioid overdoses
    - Can access data through EMS, hospital, police departments, etc.
    - They do not include any personal information or identifiable information
    - They can make a map for you and whatever you would like to track/map
    - NJCDTF discussed school mapping
      - Risk and protective factors
      - Focus group of students
      - Trusted school personnel/advisor
      - NJCDTF
      - The NJCDTF will write an assessment of their findings
      - A meeting will be held with the schools to go over the findings and discuss resources and supports in the community
      - Middle and high school
      - Would like to do this annually to show the difference in risks
      - Lauren Sacs, SAC from the High School shared that she thinks the mapping would be helpful in the school.
