




Hazlet Library Presents

September 11 - *An Easy Death* by Charlaine Harris (Gunnie Rose; Book 1)

In this alternate history where the US has collapsed during WWII and been split into five different countries, including the southwestern territory of Texoma, Gunnie Lizbeth Rose is hired by two Russian magicians to find Alex Karkarov, and his family.

October 02 - *Hex* by Thomas Olde Heuvelt "A Tom Doherty Associates book."

Originally published as *Hex* in 2013 by Luitingh-Sijthoff in Amsterdam" - Colophon. The scenic village of Beek is in the clutches of the seventeenth-century Wyler witch whose presence is a long-kept secret, but when a group of young people decide to go viral, the witch lets the community slip into medieval practices.

November 06 - *The Woman in Cabin 10* by Ruth Ware

Lo Blacklock, a journalist who writes for a travel magazine, has an assignment on a luxury cruise with only a handful of cabins, but as the week wears on, ice-cold winds whip the deck, gray skies fall, and Lo witnesses what she can only describe as a dark and terrifying nightmare.

December 11 - *A Winter Haunting* by Dan Simmons

A once-respected college professor and novelist, Dale Stewart has sabotaged his career and his marriage - and now darkness is closing in on him. In the last hours of Halloween he has returned to the dying town of Elm Haven, his boyhood home, where he hopes to find peace in isolation.

January 08 - *Frankenstein, or the Modern Prometheus* by Mary Wollstonecraft Shelley (1797-1851)

The world's most renowned monster comes to life in this compelling novel that combines science fiction and gothic romance to tell the story of a young scientist who creates a hideous creature in an unorthodox scientific experiment.

February 05 - *The Ritual* by Adam Nevill

When four old University friends set off into the Scandinavian wilderness of the Arctic Circle, they aim to briefly escape the problems of their lives and reconnect with one another. But when Luke, the only man still single and living a precarious existence, finds he has little left in common with his well-heeled friends, tensions rise.
